Barbara Cox was one of four children born to Raleigh and Evelyn Cox in Baltimore, MD. She attended Edmondson High School and the Community College of Baltimore. After graduation from high school she was employed with Sinai Hospital and the U.S. Federal Service she re-located to California Seattle, WA and later settling in Portland, Oregon.

Barbara returned to Baltimore and transferred to the Department of Justice, Washington, DC to be closer to her mother and family. She was a civil servant with over 33 years of Federal service. when she retired from the Federal Bureau of Prison in 2005. She later enrolled at the Baltimore County Community College taking courses that provided her education and knowledge to obtain her Real Estate License which would lead to employment with Long and Foster.

She was a family oriented person and provided support to her brother to care for their mother. Barbara was a member of New Christian Memorial serving on the welcoming committee greeting guest to Sunday Service. She would later join the Liberty Service. She would later join the Liberty Senior Center and loved to travel.

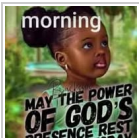
