Bea attended and graduated from Banneker Elementary Junior High School in Catonsville, Maryland. Her first job was working as an aide in the Psychiatry Unit at Spring Grove Hospital. While working there, a doctor noticed her skills and encouraged her to take nursing courses to become an LPN. She took him up on his offer and later received her nursing license in 1975 from the State of Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

Holidays were her favorite, especially Christmas, playing her Christmas music while putting up the tree and decorations, and wrapping her gifts. No matter the holiday she would get up at the crack of dawn to start cooking because she knew that her children and grandchildren were looking forward to that delicious food.

Now, Bea had her own way of saying things and was known for her catchy sayings. Pretty clever, she had what she called her after meal grace, "Belly full, heart glad, now shake a** and run mad!" or her prayer, "God bless American with these ugly a** people, and their ugly a** ways!" Some of the others were a little too expletive to say the least.

Bea was a nurturer, she loved helping and taking care of people while also taking care of her kids and grandkids. She was willing to help anyone she could. She was hard-working, loving, strong-willed, independent, full of laughter, caring, and most definitely stubborn at times, but that didn't take away the fact that she was: Beautiful inside and out, an Extraordinary person who everyone Admired and Appreciated for her Thoughtfulness, she was Respected by everyone she knew, and Irreplaceable to those who loved her, Courageous and Caring, with an Engaging smile.
