Bernard Lee Greene, Jr., was born, October 11, 1970 to Josephine and Bernard Greene Sr.

Bernard was educated in the Richmond Public Schools System. He obtained his GED the year of his high school graduation. Bernard attended J. In 2007 he became board certified as a Substance Abuse Counselor, and in 2014 he became a LCSW (License Certified Social Worker). He was previously employed with Rubicon Home Again, Veterans Administrations Drug Program and various other agencies. Recently he was employed by Henrico County and private practice under Frank Minor & Associates. Bernard joined the River City Runners of Color. As an Alumni of VCU he participated in a Missions Program to South Africa and was involved in various mentoring programs. As Bernard continued to grow spiritually, he dedicated his life to Christ and became a member of St. Paul's Baptist Church.

Despite Bernard's personal struggles, he was able to endure his strong

religious foundations influenced by his mother. His passion was helping people. He shared his blessings with many. He was dedicated to working in the drug abuse community and a spokes person for the AA program by speaking at Anniversary Milestones.

Nineteen years ago, Bernard met the love of his life, Kimlyn Brand. After a 5 year "love affair", Bernard asked for her hand in marriage. Kim was the love of his life, she was his "sunshine on a cloudy day". She was Heaven sent, God blessed him with a true Angel and he loved her with all his heart.

On Thursday, March 7, 2019, God took his hand and said to Bernard, come to me my son, I'm relieving you of all your pain. He leaves to cherish his memory his loving and devoted wife, Kimlyn Greene; two daughters, Brittany Barrett, and Bernishia Greene; two grand-children, Marley-Jai Turner and Bentleigh Haskins; mother, Josephine Greene; father, Bernard L.
