



Bernard Jackson

September 15, 1925 - July 22, 2014

Bernard Jackson was born on September 15, 1925. The family of the late Ethel and George Jackson included four children: Bernard, Marguerite, George Jr. and Phillip. Born and raised in Baltimore, Bernard was educated in the local public schools and ended at Frederick Douglass High School. As a child, he would worship in various churches within the city, and in his adult years, he enjoyed being affiliated with the Trinity Presbyterian Church. In fact, a thinking of you card from the Trinity Usher Board was found among his treasure of keepsakes.

Bernard was a member of the Merchant Marines, and he also spent time defending his country as a member of the United States Navy. He received an Honorable Discharge from this Branch of Service on October 3, 1945.

He was married to the late Eva Frances Jackson. Their marriage produced two lovely daughters in the persons of Sandra and Brenda. He provided for his family by working in the U.S. Postal Service as a mail carrier. Until his retirement, this was a job that gave him much personal satisfaction.

In his younger years, Bernard participated in track and field events. In his later years, he continued to follow those events, but he did so as an enthusiastic observer. His family recalls that he did have the skills of a baker and was known to contribute noteworthy cakes at holiday times. He particularly enjoyed watching westerns, and he maintained a vast collection of western-themed DVDs.

Bernard is remembered by his family members as being thoughtful of others,

and yet calm and unassuming. He quietly transitioned to Eternal Life on July 22, 2014. His loving memory will be treasured by: two daughters, Sandra Jackson and Brenda Trusty; a sister, Marguerite Wood; two brothers, George B. Jackson Jr. and Philip H. Jackson; two nieces, Elaine Wood and Shayna Jackson; a sister-in-law, Marva Jackson; and other caring relatives and friends.
