From this union, they were blessed with a loving son, Tyran Bernard. "Caggy" as he was affectionately known, was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Corporation working his way from coal operator to a master welder. He traveled throughout the United States and several European countries to master his trade. He finally retired in 1990, after 32 years of service, only to become the family and neighborhood handy man, taxi service, and "Honey do". Bernard was an active member of the Campfield A.M.E. Church. He became the church's maintenance advisor and major fund raiser through the can drive. During his tenure at Campfield, Brother Bernard served on the Steward Board, Men's Day Committee, and Men's Day Choir. He was very active until his illness prevented him from attending. He was a proud and devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend. Bernard

On Monday, October 24, 2005 at 1:05 a.m., Bernard gained his independence and entered a place where the soul is safe and free to live with God through eternity.
