Bertha Mae Levine was born November 23, 1939 to the late Elder Sandy Wilson, Sr. and the Late Mother Rebecca Wilson in Honey Hill, South Carolina. She was the tenth of fourteen children. After a lengthy illness at Genesis Homewood Center, God dispatched His angels to bring Bertha home on May 23, 2018.

She received her education in Berkley County Public School system in Jamestown, South Carolina.

On January 21, 1956, she was joined in holy matrimony to the love of her life, the late Samuel "Scrappy" Levine, Sr. of Shulerville, South Carolina. From this union eight children were born. In pursuit of better opportunities Samuel, Bertha and her young children moved to Baltimore, MD. in 1963.

Bertha and her family joined the Highway Church of Christ under the leadership of the late Bishop Fred Page, Sr. She served as a faithful member of the Highway Gospel Choir, Mass Choir, Hospitality Committee and the Usher board.
