OUR MATRIARCH, BESSIE ELLA BEARD, daughter of the late John Q. Smith Sr. and Emily Smith was born on July 21, 1936, in Glencoe, Maryland. On Sunday, September 28, 2025, Bessie transitioned at home surrounded by her loving family and entered in eternal rest with the Lord.

Bessie was affectionately known as “Momma,” “Mom Mom,” “Sugarfoot,” and “Pullus” by her family and friends.

Bessie was raised in Northern Baltimore County, in the communities of Glencoe and Sandy Bottom. While her father was serving in the Navy and stationed in Oakland, California, her mother, brother John, and Bessie relocated there for three years. After returning to Maryland, the family settled in Lutherville.

Bessie received her education through the Baltimore County Public School System. Bessie married the love of her life, Hilton C. Beard, on December 31, 1952. To this union six children were born, Deborah, Patricia, Linda, Jo Ann, Hilton Jr., and Reginald. Later in life after the passing of her parents, Bessie and Hilton lovingly welcomed and nurtured their adopted daughter, Yvette Wood, cherishing her as their own.

Bessie was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Hilton C. Beard Sr.;

two daughters, Patricia and Deborah; son, Reginald Beard; three sisters, Alice Adams, Emily Maddox, and Alfaretta Wilkerson; and brother, John Q. Smith Jr.

Bessie received Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at Edgewood United Methodist Church under the leadership of Rev. M.M. Jefferson. Bessie was employed by the Baltimore City Public School System as a Paraprofessional. She retired after 32 years of service from Guilford Elementary/Middle School.

She loved traveling and shopping, and she and Jo Ann were always on the go – joined by their side-kick Lashe'. She especially looked forward to the family's annual vacations to Williamsburg, VA. Boy, did she wear Jo Ann out with shopping. Bessie also cherished her three trips to Disney World, where she

became a child again – beaming with joy as she took pictures with the Disney characters.

In the last two years she became a Ravens fan. Lamar Jackson was her favorite. She loved watching television – especially Wheel of Fortune, Dr. Pimple Popper, Dr. Pol, and most of all, her favorite: westerns.
