Bessie Mae Bracey, the oldest child of the late Huie and Alberta Stevenson was born November 20, 1920 in Winnsboro, South Carolina. She passed into eternal rest on July 8, 2005 at home after a brief illness. Bessie was employed at City Hospital for thirty years until she retired in 1963. Bessie was educated in the Winnsboro, South Carolina public school system. Bessie moved to Baltimore, Maryland in 1942. Later she joined the New Friendship Baptist church under the leadership of the late Rev. Joseph Culp. 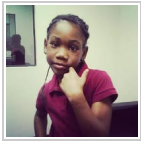
