Betsy Laverne Kernodle Gunn, 69, of Richmond, Virginia, departed this life on March 26, 2021. She was preceded in death by her parents, Willie J. Kernodle and Lavinia Galloway Kernodle; and two brothers, Willie and Kenneth Kernodle.

Betsy attended Danville Community College, Apex Beauty College and received a BA Degree from Saint Paul’s College. Betsy began her teaching career at George Washington High School in Danville, Virginia, where she served for 3 years. She would later teach at Caroline High School, Caroline County, Virginia, serving her students for 30 years of dedicated service. Betsy was passionate about her work with students. She loved her students and they loved her.

At the young age of 12 she was baptized and joined Mount Lebanon Baptist Church in Danville Virginia. There she served faithfully until she moved to Richmond, Virginia where she transferred her membership to Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church. Betsy was a faithful servant at Rising Mount Zion Baptist

Church serving in many capacities. She also served on the Trustee Ministry and Leader/Teacher of the New Members Ministry. She gave of her time freely and enjoyed her work with her church family.
