BEULAH LOUISE TAYLOR, beloved daughter of the late Roxie and Norman Dredde was born August 8, 1927 in Baltimore, Maryland. She was the mother of four children, Joyce C. Matthews, Timothy E. Taylor (who preceded her in death), Stephanie C. Bennett and Robin E. Taylor. She received her education in the public schools of Baltimore. Beulah met and married the late Edgar B. Taylor. Later, Beulah worked as a Crossing Guard for Baltimore City from 1956-1958. She then joined the staff of Baltimore City Hospitals in 1961 as a Dietary Aide until 1984. After leaving Baltimore City Hospitals (now known as Bayview Medical Center), she went onto Baltimore City Detention Center where she was employed in Dietary. She retired from this position in June of 1991. At an early age, Beulah accepted Jesus as her Savior and was a recent member of Greater Gethsemane. 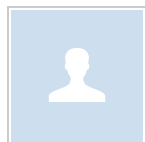

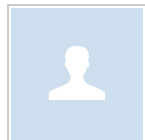
