Upon graduation from high school, she matriculated to Virginia State University, where she received a Bachelor of Science degree. She received a clinical license in social work in 1998. Dora gave 39 years of dedicated service to the Commonwealth of Virginia. She worked eleven years at Central State Hospital, five years working at Southside Virginia Training Center, and more than 23 years working with Richmond Behavioral Health Authority.
