A Time to be Born - Ecclesiastes 3:2 Beulah Beatrice Dale was born on August 16, 1931 in Chester, Pennsylvania, the seventh child of the late Wilbur and Beatrice Dale. She was the caring and loving sister of her four brothers, Wilbur, Bill, Albert, Joseph and Butcher Dale and three sisters, Cecil, Madelyn and Elizabeth all of who preceded her in death.
