BEVERLY ANN JACKSON FOGG made her entry into this world and the lives of many on October 28, 1951 in Richmond, Virginia. She was the oldest of five siblings born to Robert and Ann Jackson. She finally succumbed to her seven year battle with ovarian cancer on Thursday, April 6, 2006. Beverly was educated in the Baltimore City public school system. She graduated from Eastern High School in 1969. An excellent student, she graduated with honors from Morgan State University in 1973. She was employed at Morgan State University where she completed a host of duties and roles from 1973 until her retirement in 2001. On August 26, 1972, Beverly married Percy Isaiah Fogg and from this union they were blessed with her pride and joy, her son, Percy Ivan Fogg. Beverly is most noted for being a loving and kind person, but especially noteworthy is her example as a loving sister, wife, and mother. Beverly was dedicated and baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses on March 22, 1980. Among the many happy moments in her life is the start of her pioneer ministry in 1999, attending the pioneer service school in June 2000, and her share in the ministry in the Russian Community and the formation of the Baltimore Russian Congregation. She truly loved her God Jehovah and wanted everyone to know him. Beverly leaves to cherish her memory, her husband Percy and son Percy Ivan; Derek Fogg, a stepson; her father, Robert Jackson, Sr., and mother, Ann Jackson Maroney; grandmother, Mary Ann Duson of Long Island, NY; two sisters, June Hilliard Terry, and Regina Maureen Jackson; two brothers, Robert Jackson, Jr., and Reginald Maurice
