Ferguson, Sr. Although she put up a courageous fight, she succumbed to illness on July 7, 2014. Beverly, affectionately known as “E”, was the second oldest of five children. As she approached her retirement in December, 2012, she commented, “I never realized when I started working in NSA that I would make so many wonderful friends, that I would take part and do some of the most interesting work and that together we would face so many challenges and do great things.” Beverly was devoted to her family and enjoyed family gatherings. She took joy in trying new recipes to share at get-togethers. She loved to shop and her two favorite stores were Chico’s and Talbots. She also loved collecting unique pieces of jewelry and artwork.
