Beverly was truly a loving Daughter, Mother, Sister, Grandmother, and friend. She would always refer to her daughter-in-love, Brenda, as “The daughter she never had”. She was a confidant and would hold to your deepest secrets. She was always praying for and concerned about others. She studied the word of God and spoke it daily over her life and in the lives of so many others. Always confessing the goodness of GOD. She was loved and adored by ALL in the Christian community as well as her close circle of friends whom she adored.

She would often say “if I told you all the things that GOD has done for me, we

would all miss work and church tomorrow.”

Beverly was educated through Richmond Public Schools and graduated from Maggie Walker. She had a strong background in Supervision. She worked for 37 years at The Westvaco company and was a spokesman for Westvaco and Philip Morris USA companies as well as one of the 1st Black Supervisors at Westvaco. Through her faith in GOD, ALL the honor went to GOD for landing this position as a supervisor. She would tell everyone “I didn’t have the qualifications, but I had JESUS ... and Guess Who Got the Job.”
