July 22, 1969 - March 28, 2002

Billy C. Green II (fondly known as Junior), passed away Thursday, March 28, 2002 at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, Maryland. He was born July 22, 1969 in Gary, Indiana to Billy (deceased) and Anita L. Green. Billy was employed at Catholic Relief Services in Baltimore as an Assistant Regional Representative for Africa. Billy gave his life to God at an early age and had attended the Evening Star Missionary Baptist Church in Gary, Indiana where at that time, Nathaniel Cusic, Sr. was the pastor. Billy graduated from West Side High School (Gary, Indiana) in 1988. He obtained a Baccalaureate Degree from Iowa State University (Ames, Iowa) in 1993, and became a member of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, inc. Billy joined the United States Peace Corps (1993-1996) after he graduated from Iowa State, and spent three years in Cameroon, Africa. Billy worked for AmeriCorps from 1996-1997, but decided to further his education at Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. In the summer of 1999, Billy was awarded an internship and served at the U.S. Embassy in Jamaica. Billy obtained a Masters Degree in Public Administration from Indiana University in December 2000. Billy then moved to Baltimore, Maryland, where he spent time substitute teaching at Dundalk Middle School and Dundalk High School. At the time of his death, Billy spoke five foreign languages. Billy is survived by his mother, Anita L. Green of Gary, Indiana; one brother, Lance J. Green (Carie) of Clarksville, Tennessee; sisters, Kathryn Greenlaw (Arthur) of Gary, Indiana, Annetta Hillman (David) of Killeen, Texas, Monika Lanier (Jeffrey) of Carbondale,

Illinois and Natalie Green of Gary, Indiana. He also leaves behind seven nieces, six nephews, several aunts and uncles, and many friends and loved ones. Billy will be missed and remembered by all.

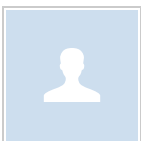

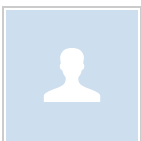

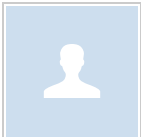
