Until his sudden death, Bona worked for the Maryland State Department of Education, Division of Rehabilitation Services (DORS) as a Staff Specialist for the Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing for several years, and was nearing retirement. Bona served as a member of the Mayor's Commission on Disabilities in Baltimore City. Bona also served in numerous Baltimore City Community programs for the deaf. Bona received numerous awards for his dedication in the education of the deaf and hard of hearing which includes awards by the United States Department of Agriculture, and the State of Maryland Governor's award. Bona was for many years, and active member of Bethel A.M.E. Church. Bona made numerous friends where he went and will sincerely be missed by everyone who knew him.
