



## Boyce William Barton Jr.

July 10, 1932 - November 9, 2012

BOYCE WILLIAM BARTON, JR. was born on July 10, 1933, to Boyce William Barton, Sr. and Hattie Richardson in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on November 9, 2012.

He graduated from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School, June 1950, where he acquired the nickname of "Heels". Boyce was a very good athlete and while there he lettered in track, swimming, rifle and boxing. He joined the United States Air Force just after high school. After a stint in the service, he attended Morgan State College and was on their swimming team and became a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity.

Boyce became a Baltimore City Fireman and later worked in printing companies as a Pressman. He married Margaret Tann from Philadelphia, PA with whom they had a daughter, Deborah Louise. They later divorced.

He was a long time resident of the East Baltimore neighborhoods; his many friends later affectionately knew him as "Slim". Boyce was a fun loving soul who was well liked with a care free spirit and a winning smile and ready handshake.

At the age of sixty-two, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and was baptized. A staunch member of East Baltimore's Urban Bible Fellowship

Church; he never missed a Bible Study Class.

In the last ten years after his health failed, he resided at Charlotte Hall Veteran's Home. He is survived by: a daughter, Deborah Louise Barton; stepmother, Missouri O. Barton; brother, Jim Davenport; sister-in-law, Frances Davenport; niece, Michelle Johnson; and a nephew, Gary West; along with many cousins and long-time friends.
