August 1, 1940 - March 7, 2021

Bunoan Wu was born in Battambang, Cambodia on August 1, 1940. He is preceded by his parents, Mr. Eng Huot Ngo and Mrs. Lap Tan; two brothers, Bun Hoa (Ngo) Wu and Bun Long Ngo; sister, Watt Eng Ngo; first wife, Gandhimathi Rama; and step-grandson, Elijah Malone. Bunoan came to the United States in 1979, escaping the Khmer Rouge, and migrated to Montgomery County, Maryland where he met his second wife, Samnang Nhel, and started his journey for a better life.

Bunoan was a respected local government employee, for 15 years, with the Montgomery County Public School system. He taught himself to read and write English, toting a taped up dictionary that he routinely used for more than 30 years. He was a hardworking husband and father who provided for his family. He loved the outdoors, taking family road trips across the States, and practicing tai chi. His love of traveling included trips and cruises, throughout Europe, and frequent visits to family in France and Cambodia. Although an avid traveler, he also loved the home life of grocery shopping, cooking food, cleaning, planting fruit trees, watching sports, enjoying YouTube, doing home improvement projects, and reading Buddhist scriptures.

Bunoan loved taking outdoor walks and was blessed to enjoy that activity and witness the outdoor beauty as he departed from his life on Earth to start his next journey in the afterlife. He leaves behind his wife, Samnang Wu;

daughters, Dina Rama Dean and Mariyane Hao; step-daughter, Meta Lim; son, Monorom Wu; step-grandchildren, Alyssa Lim and Justin Malone; sisters, Kuy Eng Ngor and Kuy Oan Ngor; and a host of nieces, nephews, and extended family.
