She was born in Clarksdale, Mississippi, but raised on the Southside of Chicago, Illinois. After marrying Maurice J. Price Sr., they moved to Baltimore, Maryland where she was a housewife and dedicated mother. She attended Antioch College. She also counseled teenagers and young adults, quickly becoming the neighborhood MOM. She began her career as a secretary for Clarence "Du" Burns. There were various career changes to name a few: State of Maryland Uninsured Motorist also known as MAIF, Manor Care Ruxton where she enjoyed working with the elderly and Sinai Hospital as a Patient Advocate where coworkers, patients and their families became her family. She raised seven children, but she was truly the mother and grandmother of many. There was no end to how far her love could spread. Unable to finish her education early in life, she proudly obtained her G.E.D. at the Caroline Center for women in 1997 at the age of fifty-six.
