CALVIN JACSEN BELLE SR. was born on March 8, 1952 in Brooklyn, NY. He was the third child of five born to Oscar Lee and Louzellia Belle. He was baptized at an early age at the First Church of God in Far Rockaway, NY. He was joined in holy matrimony to Blondell Washington, June 13, 1977.

Calvin received his early education in the NYC Public School system and graduated from Lawrence High School in Nassau County, NY in 1970.
