At an early age Calvin got his first job at a neighborhood grocery store until his teenage years, then he went to work for Bethlehem Steel for a year then moved on to Holly Poultry where he made career there for over thirty years.

Calvin received Christ at an early age. He spent most of his time in California with his father who was the Bishop of the Pentecostal way of Truth Church. Calvin loved to play the piano.

During his stay in California he was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. He later returned to Baltimore to be close to his mother. After the passing of his mother his health began to spiral down, but that did not stop him from spending his summer in California. As time went on Calvin lost the use of his legs and was wheelchair bound. He would ride the wheelchair like it was sport car, now you see him and now you don't. He would often get in his wheelchair and go to Mt Calvary Church to hear Pastor Farrow preach, accompanied by his nephew his road partner AK.

When he get back home he would Pastor preached up a storm. He loved to go to church as long as his health would allow him. Later on in 2005 Calvin was no longer able to get around his illness took him to another level which left him bedridden, he spent a lot of time in and out of the hospital, but through it all he held on to his independence.

This past year and a half was the worse, and the pain was too severe. During his last few days even in the amount of pain he was in he was able to smile.
