



Calvin E. Tyler Sr.

December 4, 1920 - September 15, 2016

Calvin Ellsworth Tyler Sr., the fourth child of Harry and Louise Tyler, was born December 4, 1920.

Calvin was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. He was briefly employed with the B&O Railroad, following in the footsteps of his Dad who died when Calvin was only 9 years old.

Calvin met and married Anita Tyler (nee Howell) in 1942. Of this union three boys were born; Calvin Jr., Robert, and Reginald (Butch).

Calvin enlisted in the United States Navy during World War II and received an Honorable Discharge in 1945. After the war, Calvin gained employment with the former C&P Telephone company where he worked for 39 years, rising to a position of Supervisor, before retiring in 1981.

Calvin and Lucille Tyler (nee Johnson) were married in the early 70's. The two of them spent their retirement years enjoying many trips and cruises with friends and family.

Calvin generously contributed both time and efforts as a Junior Achievement Advisor developing a better understanding and appreciation of the American youth for our Private Enterprise Economy.

At the time of his death, Calvin was the oldest member of the Arch Social Club. He was also a member of the Associated Social Club. Calvin and his wife enjoyed many outings and trips with members of this club where he formed a close friendship with co-member, Charles Tubman.

Calvin was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters Josephine and Marie; one brother, Gilbert; and a special cousin Evelyn.

After a long courageous battle with kidney disease, Calvin departed this life on September 15, 2016.

Calvin leaves to mourn: his wife, Lucille Tyler; three sons, Calvin Jr., Robert and Reginald Tyler; two step-daughters, Ernestine McDonald, Carolyn Byrd. Calvin is also survived by several grandchildren, great-grandchildren, other relatives.
