Calvin Williams, son of the late John and Eva Williams, was born on February 5, 1946 in Baltimore Maryland. He was one of eight siblings.

Calvin received his formal education in the Baltimore City Public School System, graduating from The Paul Laurence Dunbar Community High School in 1964, and has been a member of the 1964 Dunbar Alumni Committee. Upon completing his high school education, Calvin gained employment at the Bethlehem Steel Corporation, Sparrows Point, Maryland. Shortly thereafter, he enlisted in the United States Army where he served in the Vietnam War. Upon his 3-year tenure in the United States Army, he returned home and resumed work at Bethlehem Steel. While at Bethlehem Steel, he decided to continue his education and enrolled at the Dundalk Community College where he received a degree in home improvement. Calvin retired from "the Point" after being employed for almost 40 years of service.

As a child, Calvin accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Savior. He was baptized and became a member of the Grace Memorial Baptist Church where he faithfully attended with his family.

He later joined the fellowship of the Israel Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Dr. H.

Walden Wilson, II. Calvin served faithfully on IsraeTs Culinary Ministry, Security Ministry and the Men's Ministry. He would join The Men's Wednesday Morning Prayer Line every week.

In 1972, Calvin began dating a young lady, and her name - Cecelia. The couple were united in Holy Matrimony on December 16, 1976, and from this union, they were blessed with five children.

After a brief retirement, Calvin worked as a security guard at the Good Samaritan Hospital for over five years. Upon taking his full retirement, he took the time to do some of the things he loved: traveling and being with family and friends. Calvin also enjoyed cooking and could throw down "on the grill!". He was an avid sports enthusiast and enjoyed attending the Baltimore Ravens and Philadelphia Eagles Football Games with his family.

On Thursday, September 15, 2022, after a lengthy illness, Calvin Williams transitioned from

this earthly life to his eternal home. He is now in the presence of Jesus and has reunited with his parents and three of his siblings, Ruth, Rosemary and Barbara (who preceded him in death).
