CALON GLADNEY DOUGH, known to many as Nanny, was the fifth and youngest child born to the late Frank and Laura Sloan Gladney of Fairfield County, Winnsboro, South Carolina, departed this life on Tuesday, December 28, 2010.

She received several grades of education at the Shady Grove Methodist Church, discontinuing school to work along with her family on the farm.

At age nineteen, Calon traveled from South Carolina to Baltimore, which became her permanent home. Married young, later divorce. Mother of three children, one daughter, Magalene Douglas Brown. Her two sons, Wallace Gladney and Harold "Big Charm" Douglas, preceded her in death.

In 1943, Calon met James "Jimmy" Rodgers and the two bonded a relationship that lasted until his death in 1987.

During her years of raising her three children, Calon was a Domestic Worker for many years. Her last job was at Misty Harbor, leaving in 1963 due to her health disabilities. Some of her favorite things to do were to cook, go to Pimlico Race Track, play the slots, the lottery and take time to call and visit relatives and friends.
