CARLTON TYRONE MAYO passed away in Baltimore, Maryland on Friday, August 4, 2023. Carlton (affectionately known as “Perk”) was born on August 30, 1954, in Norfolk, Virginia to Levi N. Perkins and Verna M. Mayo.

Carlton grew up in Norfolk, Virginia where he graduated from Lake Taylor High School. After graduation, he attended Norfolk State University where he studied Communications. Carlton was very well known and spent time in a funk band as a singer. After leaving college, Carlton moved to Baltimore, Maryland in 1979 where he worked in the hospitality industry before transitioning to Baltimore City Schools. Later in his professional career, Carlton worked directly for several rental car companies in the Baltimore area.

Carlton had the unique ability to find humor in most situations. He had a lot of informal mentoring relationships with “the young boys” and often referred to everyone as “Jack”. Carlton was a collector of albums and had a deep love for music. You could often find him on Sundays playing a record, tape or CD, and cooking meats from the local market.

Carlton loved visiting Norfolk as often as he could to spend time with family and friends. One of the highlights of his time in Norfolk included regularly attending the Berkeley Reunion, a community-based gathering of family and friends.

Carlton is preceded in death by his father, Levi N. Perkins. Carlton leaves to cherish his memory: mother, Verna M.
