Carolyn Elizabeth Foote Dunnmoodie was born in Calvert County, Maryland on March 12, 1939 to the late Blanche Elizabeth Gough and Leonard Preston Foote. Carolyn was the second oldest of five children.

Carolyn was educated within the Calvert County Public School System and the Community College of Baltimore City. While residing in Calvert County, Carolyn accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her Savior.

During the early 1960's, Carolyn relocated to Baltimore in order to pursue her professional career as a licensed practical nurse. Carolyn was a caregiver and demonstrated her gift by working at Levindale Hebrew Geriatric Center and Rosewood State Hospital. Also, she provided private duty nursing care. Carolyn accepted her neighbors deliveries and reminded the neighbors when the recycling or street cleaning trucks were coming. The neighbors trusted her with the keys to their homes, but most of all they entrusted her with their children.
