Carrie Bullock "Kemba", 68 of Baltimore, MD, was called home on July 29, 2020 in Aberdeen, MD.

Carrie Bullock was born in Baltimore, MD to Betty Bea Bullock and Moses Bullock on April 11, 1952. She attended the Baltimore City Public School System. Carrie Bullock affectionately known as Kemba and Claudia grew up in a loving home with strong Christian values. Her faith in God was so deeply rooted and unshakeable. It guided her through her toughest struggles in life. She has been described as kind, loving, caring, giving, revolutionary, spirited, passionate, fashionable, driven, and relentless. She was ever evolving as a human being.

She lived to serve her community. In her earlier years she marched with the Black Panthers for social justice, was a member of the Black Peoples Topographical Research Center, aided in the development and implementation of a community food Co-Op and farms to provide nutritious foods for her community. Carrie Bullock aided in establishing a school for community youth named Timbuktu Shule School. In her earlier years she was deeply into veganism, staying physically fit, and living a healthy lifestyle, prior to it being a fad.

Carrie believed in fighting the good fight and participated in marches that

would aid in making Martin Luther King Jr. birthday a national holiday and in the Million Man March. In her latter days she was so compelled by the social issues still confronting society and desired to participate in protests. Her condition however limited her participation in these endeavors but her heart was there.

Carrie entered matrimony in 1979 and was married for eight years to Patrick Anthony Thomas.

She volunteered for the Baltimore City Fire Department. Carrie attended Bay College, Morgan State University, and Towson University where she secured her Licensed Practical Nurse licensure. She worked as an LPN in various nursing homes and correctional facilities. She took great pride in providing care to her patients. She was always willing to step in when she saw someone in a vulnerable or compromised state. Carrie also thwarted an armed individual from boarding a plane as a TSA agent.

In her search for higher awareness and understanding she studied Christianity and Islamic religions. Her greatest joy in life was being a mother to her nine children and a grandmother to her thirteen grandchildren. She loved children so much that she would often welcome other children into her home and treat them as her own. Down to adding more children to an already overcrowded car to take everyone out for the day. She is noted to have said that I was created to bring forth life.

Carrie had her stumbles and struggles in her journey of life but always managed to somehow overcome them.

Carrie Bullock was preceded in death by her parents (Betty Bea Bullock and Moses Bullock) and her siblings (Augustus Bullock, Sylvia Bullock, and Betty Bullock).

Her beautiful life will always be cherished in the lives of her children: Yousef, Jonathan (Onajee), Natasha Miasha, Edson, Nefertiti, Raheem, Malcolm, Alim; her siblings: Moses Bullock, Marine Bullock Mitchell, her thirteen loving grandchildren, devoted nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
