CASSANDRA AGATHA RILEY, daughter of Mildred Franks and the late George Ray Riley, was born October 19, 1956. She departed this life on Sunday, July 15, 2012 after valiantly battling lung cancer.

(San)dra, as she was lovingly called, received her formal education in the Baltimore City Schools. She graduated from Carver Vocation Technical H.S. in 1974 where she completed the practical nursing program. In 1989, she obtained her Associate of Art degree in nursing from the Community College of Baltimore. In 1994, she obtained her Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from Coppin State College. She successfully passed the state board exams to become a registered nurse, RN.

As a registered nurse, her family was blessed with her passion for labor and delivery. Sandra worked as a nurse or was present in the delivery room for 10 of the 12 births of her nieces and nephews. She had a commanding, yet gentle and reassuring spirit in the delivery room; often being requested to work with high risk or problem patient, such as drug addicts or prisoners. She worked at Sinai hospital from 1978-1998, Genesis Nursing Home from 1998-2001, and Mercy Medical Center from 2001-2008. Her hard and dedicated work earned her a Gold Star award in labor and delivery.

Sandra's memory will be cherished by her mother Mildred Franks; brother B.
