Along with her mother, Cassie attended Lee Cross Road Baptist Church in Johnston County, NC. In her teens, Cassie moved to Baltimore, Md. and attended Douglass High School. Cassie married the love of her life the late Alfred Stewart, Jr. From that union one daughter was born, Patricia.

Cassie attended Gillis Memorial Christian Community Church in Baltimore. She worked for a short time at Mrs. Ihries Potato Chip Factory; and, many years at the General Electric Company, from which she retired in 1990. Cassie enjoyed talking to and helping others; so, she came out of retirement and became a nurse assistant at Home Instead Senior Care. At Home Instead, Cassie provided non-medical in-home care for the elderly. She provided transportation for her clients for doctors appointments and she took them shopping.

Cassie enjoyed traveling to visit family in North Carolina, and fishing. She enjoyed long phone calls to catch up with loved ones, cooking and entertaining her friends and relatives. Cassie loved to dance and to listen to old love songs. Some of her favorites were "Please Come Home For Christmas" by Charles Brown, "I've Been Loving You Too Long" by Otis Redding and "At Last" by Etta James. Cassie lived in Pimlico, an area of

Baltimore City, until she could no longer live alone due to her illness. The Lord kept Cassie with us until she was 83 years old and just a little over a month she became 84 years old.
