"Mama" loved to talk and always had an old homeopathic remedy for any physical or mental ailment. She kept in touch with her close friends and spoke with her family daily. As the years rolled by, "Mama" battled numerous illnesses and eventually became confined to her home. Although she was unable to attend church, she

loved the Lord with all her heart and soul and she never stopped reading the bible and quoting her favorite scripture, the 23rd Psalm. "Mama" was loved by all and will be truly missed.
