June 11, 1926 - April 18, 2012

Cecelia M. Horton, the fifth child of the late Walter C. and Annie M. Curtis, was born on June 11, 1926. After a brief illness, her life on earth ended on April 18, 2012.

Cecelia is a product of the Baltimore Catholic School System. She was a St. Frances Academy Class of 1945 Alumni. She was later employed at the Baltimore Country Club, the General Service Administration and finally the Food and Drug Administration as a Microbiology Technician. Cecelia or "Ms. Cielely" as she was affectionately known by all the children in the neighborhood was always available for long discussions and problem solving. When she became a grandmother, she traded her familiar Ms. Cielely in for Granny. From that time on she will always be known as Granny; a title she never took lightly.
