Charles Kenneth Burrell, 82, of New Kent, passed away peacefully on April 19, 2026. He was born on December 9, 1943, in New Kent, VA to the late Louis Herman Burrell, Sr. and Florence Edna Burrell. He is preceded in death by his siblings Billie Barbour, Herman “Chick” Burrell Jr., and Joyce Turpin, and step-son, Tony Blankenship.

He served in Helicopter Training Squadron 8 in Pensacola, Florida. After retiring from the Navy, he worked 9 years for the

United States Postal Service.

He attended Cumberland Elementary School and graduated from G. W. Watkins School, where he was Salutatorian of the class of 1962.

Kenneth enjoyed hunting, fishing, and playing cards with friends and family, and he was an avid dog lover.
