He was later transferred to Fort Hood, Texas and assigned as a member of the 1st Battalion, 6th Field Artillery Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, and 1st Infantry Division. During his tenure in the U.S. Army, Specialist Clements was deployed to Kosovo, Iraq and two tours in Afghanistan where he was currently serving. His awards include the Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal. During his military career he made many friends who will miss him very much. When away from the military, nothing gave Charles more pleasure than having fun, laughing and joking with his family and friends. Charles loved his church

family and always desired to attend services when in town.
