CHARLES FRANKLIN DeSHAZO, JR. was born on December 12, 1938 in Glen Rogers, West Virginia. He was the oldest of nine children born to Charles and Mary DeShazo. His parents, his brother, Herbert; and his sister, Deloris all preceded him in death.

While at an early age, he was baptized at the First Baptist Church of Glen Rogers. After completing Conley High School in Mullens, West Virginia, he joined the United States Army and was honorably discharged after two years.

In 1962, the family relocated to Baltimore, Maryland, settling in Turner's Station. In 1965, he was joined in Holy Matrimony with Alice T. Hill. They were blessed with three daughters.

Charles had a zealous desire to have his own business. During this journey, he was blessed with several businesses over the years: Shazo's Sub Shop, Twizzer, Inc., S&D Tires and Pulaski Tire Service.

During his travels, he often visited the West Coast, where he sought out and received alternative medical treatment because of a bad heart. This treatment was so successful, that he was taken off the heart transplant list and was able to have a better quality of life.

In his last days, he was spiritually fed and comforted by ministers of several denominations. He was a member of St. Francis Xavier and was recently anointed and given the Last Rites of the Catholic Church. On Saturday, August 4, 2013, after a lengthy battle with heart disease, our loved one left this earthly place to be with our Father, where there is no pain nor suffering, but everlasting peace.

He is survived by: his wife of forty-eight years, Alice T. DeShazo; four daughters, Shawna F. DeShazo, Carol DeShazo Price, Constance F. DeShazo and Dr. Chaunte F. Harris; eight grandchildren, Aron (who was “the apple of his eye”) and Amber DeShazo, DePaul and Leah Hill, Janele and James Price, Jonathan and Jada Harris; one great-grandson, Aron DeShazo Jr.; three sisters, Mary Mackel, Rosetta Deshazo and Alice M. DeShazo; three brothers, Robert, Vernell and Herman DeShazo; two sons-in-law, four sisters-in-law, one brother-in-law; and numerous nephews, nieces, cousins and friends.
