CHARLES EDWARD FIGG was born on March 23, 1945 in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Gertrude and William Figg. Charles departed this life Saturday, December 5, 2020. Five sisters and one brother, Agnes, Louis, Serena, Juanita, Cora, and Freddie preceded him in death.

Charles, also known as Boopy (childhood nickname), was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and attended Dunbar High School. Soon after he graduated he enlisted to the U.S. Army. After serving three years in the army he was honorably discharged in 1966. Charles began working for Western Electric for years until they relocated headquarters forcing him to retire.
