CHARLES HUGHES JR., son of the late Charles Hughes Sr. and Albertha Gullledge was born June 15, 1934 in Hammond, Louisiana. He was also the brother to Martha Bradley who was his devoted caregiver.

Charles received his education in the Hammond Public School System where he graduated from Greenville Park High School. He went on to further his education at South Eastern College, majoring in Business Administration. He also attended Seattle Community College where his course of study included Programming, Mathematics and English.

In 1956, Charles began employment with the Boeing Company of Seattle, Washington. During his extensive career there, he held several positions including Lead Fabricator Assembler, Shop Coordinator, Department Supervisor and Supervisor for the Mock-up Department. His last place of employment was with Domino Sugar where he served as Plant Manager.

Charles was married to the former Audrey Smith and out of this union 3 children were born, Vanessa, Charles and Valorie.
