Charles graduated from City High School in 1984 and attended University of Maryland, Eastern Shore where he became a member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Incorporated.

Charles was taught the life of Christ at an early age. His Christian walk started a Holy Grace Memorial Temple under the pastorate of Dr. Delores Brooks. He was a member of the junior choir and sung his first lead song. " While I'm Down Here Praying, Lord Search My Heart", at the age of 6.
