



Charles Lawrence Jearmon

August 16, 1916 - March 11, 2003

Charlie L. Jearmon, son of the late Joshua Jearmon and Agnes Jearmon, was born August 16, 1916 in Bertie County, North Carolina. He departed this life on Tuesday, March 11, 2003. Charlie left North Carolina at the age of 16 and moved to Baltimore, Maryland, where he resided until his death. He married the late Octavia Rose in February, 1952. They were departed by her death in 1991. Charlie served his country in World War II being honorably discharged on June 27, 1946. While serving he received a Silver Star, and American Theatre Ribbon, a European-African-Middle Eastern Theatre Ribbon, a World War II Victory Ribbon and a Good Conduct Medal. His career path led him into work for the Federal Government where he retired as a supervisor for GSA in 1979. Charlie enjoyed buying cars, interior decorating (which he was quite good at decorating his home), watching TV, and entertaining his neighbors. He leaves to mourn: two daughters, Sylvia Annette Carter and Gloria Jearmon-Smith; a sister, Rosie Lee Simmons; son-in-law, David Smith; six grandchildren, Richard Jr., Kevin, Melissa, and Christopher Carter, Joshua and Ethan Smith; nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
