able to attend church services, but enjoyed his visits from the Deacons of First Baptist Church of Cherry Hill.

Charles was a devoted husband and loving father. In 1975 after a brief courtship he married the love of his life, Elvin.

Charles was preceded in death by his siblings, Harry, Bertha, Laura and George.
