CHARLES SMALLS, was born to the late Louise Jones and Moses Smalls on July 22, 1958 in Anne Arundel County (Pumphrey), Maryland. He was raised at an early age by his late grandparents Euline and Charles James Wallace. He was known as “Man” to close friends and family because he was the first born son. Charles was preceded by one sister Eva Fullard.

He was educated in Anne Arundel County Public School and was a graduate of Brooklyn Park High School.

Charles married Joyce Miller and helped raise his step-son Eric, William, and Corey. Right after this reunion Charles enlisted in the Army Branch of the United States Military, where he served for several years and received a “Good Conduct” Medal twice. own. Just prior to Charles becoming severely ill, he became engaged to be married to Tonya Vann and was baptized during his illness.

He loved watching the Baltimore Ravens Football Team and would not miss a game. Charles had a strong commitment to family. But most of all he loved and took great pride in being a single dad to his children.
