Charles Sterling Gaither entered quietly and peacefully into eternal rest on Thursday, November 29, 2001 at his home. Sterling, son of the late Clifton S. and Catherine H. Gaither, was born in Anne Arundel County on January 8, 1919. He received his education in the public schools of Anne Arundel County. His religious training began as a child when he attended church with his mother, who was a devout Catholic. He attended St. Monica's Catholic Church in Baltimore.
