Our beloved mother, Charlotte P. Henderson went to be with our heavenly Father on July 10, 2015 in Beaver Falls, PA. She had just celebrated her 90th birthday a month earlier.

Charlotte was born on June 9, 1925 in the outskirts of Lake City, South Carolina. She was the second of Henrietta and Willie Pressley. She went to school in Lake City and lived most of her young years on a farm with her siblings, Earl (predeceased her in death), Thomas and Annie Mae. She spent her free time sewing, listening to Christian radio and taking care of her nine children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren for many years.

She worked at Bethesda Naval Medical Center, the Baltimore Country Club for many years and then at Fort Meade. She had children, Carrie Mae (Mae), Judera (Judy), Willie, Robert, Samuel (Princie), Paul (Pee-Wee), Lolita (Totsie), Mary (Bunnie), and Charles (Chucky).
