Charlotte Marie Nash, the youngest daughter of the late Barkley Davis Lane and Mother Hattie Lane Nelson, was born on June 18, 1942 in Wartrace, Tennessee. She peacefully departed on April 23, 2018.

In December 1959, she married the late Horace William Nash. Of this union were born four children, Veronica Nash, Da-Aon Nash, Vincent Nash, and DeJohn Nash.

Charlotte received her early education from Dunbar High School in Dayton, Ohio in 1958. She continued her education, earning a bachelor of arts degree in Business Administration. In 1976, she relocated to Baltimore, where she would earn her Master's degree in Early Childhood Education. She would later retire as a teacher from Baltimore City Public Schools.
