As a result Of their love and adherence to God’s command to “be fruitful and multiply” they had their first child Lawrence, Jr. on June 19, 1986, Lawrence, Jr. enjoyed being an only child until December 1, 1994 when his younger sister Helen Mariah was born.

She made friends whenever she went and was always the life of the party. She was known as a fashionista and Head Diva to her family and displayed a
