



Chester Arthur Carter

March 7, 1929 - April 16, 2012

Chester A. Carter, son of the late McKinley and Thelma Carter, was born on March 7, 1929 in Halifax, Virginia. He departed this life on April 16, 2012 after a lengthy illness. He was the fifth of nine children.

He attended school in Halifax, Virginia. He then moved to Baltimore, Maryland in 1946 where he furthered his education. He was employed by General Motors. While employed there he was attending Auto Mechanic School. He married the love of his life, Blanche Carter in 1950 and established his home. He was inducted into the United States Army in 1951 and received an honorable discharge in 1953.

In 1957 he heard the good news of what God's Kingdom was going to be for mankind and he dedicated his life as one of Jehovah's Witnesses. Chester was baptized in 1967 and he served as a pioneer in field ministry servant advancing himself in Kingdom Truths. Chester was a kind and loving person. He loved his children and grandchildren. He made sure that his family was well cared for and that they learned about Jehovah. He loved dearly most people whose lives he touched and they will miss him. His greatest love was God and second, his family, especially his children and grandchildren.
