



Chief Linus Chukwunwike Ogbogu

July 22, 1944 - April 19, 2022

Chief Linus Chukwunwike Ogbogu (Idejiogwugwu), beloved husband, father, father-in-law, grandfather, and uncle, was born July 22, 1944 in Umunya, Nigeria. He passed to eternal glory on April 19, 2022, in Baltimore, MD after a brief illness. He was married to the love of his life, late Josephine Ijeoma Ogbogu (nee Azodo), and is survived by his children, grandchildren, in-laws, uncles, relatives, and close friends.

During his life, Idejiogwugwu as he was fondly called, was an avid businessman who turned his small trading store into one of the biggest supermarkets located in Down Beach Sappa Road Limbe, Southwest Province, Republic of Cameroon. He retired in 2007 and lived with his daughter, Dr. Clara Anizoba and her husband, Engr. Felix Anizoba, here in Baltimore, USA, until his death.

Idejiogwugwu was a loving, caring and devoted husband and father. After the painful death of his beloved wife in 1981, he dedicatedly took care of his children. As many of you know, Idejiogwugwu was a strict father and disciplinarian. He lived a life of humility and integrity; and was known for his kind, caring, and generous heart. He was a living sunshine, shining brightly for those around him. He was not just a devout Catholic; his entire personality stemmed from his strong love for Jesus Christ and his devotion to the Divine Mercy prayer. In fact, dad never failed to say his three O'clock daily prayers. The Holy Bible and Rosary were his daily companion.

In his social life, Idejiogwugwu belonged to different groups such as the Lions Club of Cameroon and many others. He was a strong advocate for justice and equality amongst all people. He discovered the good in people even when someone wronged him. He did not lose hope when his younger son died in 2010.

Repe, dad, granddad, Idejiogwugwu, you lived a good life worthy of emulation. We are grateful to God that in the presence of our Lord Jesus, you - Idejiogwugwu, our father - will rest peacefully in heaven. Idejiogwuogu, ezigbo nna anyi, je nke oma. Your legacy of love, unity, faith, peace, and self-sacrifice lives on. Adieu, papa!
