Christella Marie Savage (Chrissy), daughter of the late Berdella M. Wilson and Charles L. Savage, Sr. was born on March 22, 1954 in Baltimore, Maryland. She answered the heavenly call on the morning of Wednesday, November 9, 2016.

Christella was educated in parochial school and the Baltimore City Public School System. She graduated from Forest Park High School in 1972.

It is difficult to say goodbye to someone that knew you before you knew yourself. Although Chrissy's life was cut short by illness, she did not live a boring life. When she was younger, Stella liked to party and was often the life of the party. When she was on the dance floor, everyone was watching. Our Shiska wasn't a world traveler, but we do remember the time that they almost didn't let her out of Jamaica, because her paperwork was not right. Chrissy remembered everything and everyone that crossed her path. She often told us stories in detail about what happened when we were kids. Chrissy was no angel when she was younger, we could never forget some of the epic disciplinary events bestowed upon her by our mother.

It didn't matter whether you called her Christella, Chrissy, Stell, Shiska, Stella Lumbrusco, Sis or Mom, you could count on her to share her honesty and humor with everyone. Like many of her family members, Chrissy was an excellent cook. She was known for her lasagna, spaghetti and crab soup. Even when her health was slipping away, she was still sharing recipes. Chrissy enjoyed writing poetry. She would often write poems to express gratitude to

the people in her life. Some things in life can bring an involuntary smile to your face, like listening to Ella Fitzgerald sing or having a conversation with Chrisy. She was a gifted and hilarious story teller.

Chrisy battled with depression throughout her adult life but she never let that define who she was as a person. The staff and members at Mosaic Community Services were like her second family. She had a heart full of love for her family and friends. That is who she was and that is how we will remember her.
