Christine Johnson Ford was born on May 10, 1924 to the parents of Louis and Florence Johnson of Richmond, Virginia. There she grew up and attended the public schools. She was one of the first graduates of Maggie L. Walker High School, in 1942. She later attended Catonsville Community College here in Maryland, where she majored in Beauty Culture. She then worked as a hairstylist and taught beauty culture in night school.

In June 1947 she married Russell W. Ford. She later joined him in Baltimore, Maryland where they made their home. They became parents of Russell Jr. and Louis Johnson Ford.

She later went to work for Hochschild Kohn department store. There she worked for eight years. Then she left to work for the state of Maryland in the juvenile department helping groom young women to enter the workforce. After working for 19 years she retired in 1985. She then helped raise her three grandchildren who she adores.

Christine also involved herself in working with her church, Epworth United Methodist Chapel. She belonged to the United Methodist Women of Epworth and participated in Circle 1. She was in active member of the Zeta Amicae of Greater Baltimore Auxiliary. Christine was also an active member of her church's response team. Her husband Russell of 57 years passed in November 2004.
