July 31, 1945 - September 25, 2015

Christine Leborah Robinson Hudson was born July 31, 1945 in Palatka, Florida and was the youngest daughter of Aaron David and Ernestine Bessie Robinson. Christine died peacefully in her home in Richmond, VA on September 25, 2015. She graduated from Hampton University (formerly Hampton Institute) in 1967 where she majored in Early Childhood Education, starting her professional career teaching in Hampton City Public Schools. She then went on to teach in Charlottesville and Richmond Public Schools. She earned her Master's Degree from Virginia Commonwealth University and became Director of a Head Start Program in New Kent County, VA. She is survived by her husband of 41 years, Edward L.
